RESOLUTION NO. 2226 OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND AND NOTICE OF HEARING. FOR STREET AND ALLEY VACATION, LAKE VUE NO. 2, FILE NO. V-73-36.

WHEREAS, a petition has been filed with the City of Kirkland signed by owners of interest in real property representing more than two-thirds of the property abutting upon the hereinafter described street and alley, and

 - (2) The west 1/2 of alley lying within Block 4 and the entire alley lying within Block 5 in the Plat of BURKE AND FARRAR'S KIRKLAND ADDITION to the City of Seattle Division No. 7 as recorded in Volume 19 of plats on page 70 records at King County, Washington.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED AND NOTICE OF HEARING:

2) That said public hearing will be held before the Kirkland City Council in its chambers in the Kirkland Council Building on January 21, 1974, at 8:00 P.M.
