RESOLUTION NO. 2242

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SIGN ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITIES OF BELLEVUE, BOTHELL, KIRKLAND, REDMOND AND RENTON, PROVIDING FOR FUNDING SUPPORT FOR A JOINT PUBLIC DEFENDER PROGRAM AND DESIGNATING THE CITY OF BELLEVUE TO APPLY FOR SUCH A GRANT TO THE LAW AND JUSTICE PLANNING OFFICE OF THE PLANNING AND COMMUNITY AFFAIRS AGENCY OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON FOR A GRANT UNDER THE OMNIBUS CRIME CONTROL AND SAFE STREET ACTS OF 1968 AS AMENDED, AND DESIGNATING THE CITY OF BELLEVUE AS THE ADMINISTRATOR OF SAID GRANT FUNDS SHOULD THEY BE AWARDED.

WHEREAS, the cities of Bellevue, Bothell, Kirkland, Redmond and Renton are by statute and court rule required to provide public defender services to indigent defendants charged with violations of city ordinances within their respective jurisdictions, and

WHEREAS, each of said cities desires to obtain funding to finance said services, and

WHEREAS, it is desirable that said cities jointly apply for a grant to provide said funding, and

WHEREAS, the city of Bellevue is willing to act as the lead agency in making such application and in administering the funds should such grant be awarded,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:

Section 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to sign on behalf of the City of Kirkland a contract between the cities of Bellevue, Bothell, Kirkland, Redmond and Renton providing for a joint application for grant under the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Street Acts of 1968 to be filed by the City of Bellevue with the Law and Justice Planning Office of the Planning and Community Affairs Agency of the State of Washington, and to further provide that should such grant be awarded the City of Bellevue will assume responsibility for the administration of said grant funds pursuant to the terms of said contract. Said contract shall be substantially in the form attached to the original of this resolution, the terms of which are hereby approved.

ADOPTED by majority vote of the Kirkland City Council in regular meeting on the 18th day of March 1974.
