

RESOLUTION NO. R-2266

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND
DECLARING TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 17, 1974 TO BE JOANNE GUNDERSON
CARNER DAY.

BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Kirkland,
as follows:

WHEREAS, the City of Kirkland is the home town of JoAnne
Gunderson Carner, and

WHEREAS, JoAnne has established herself as the number one
woman golfer in the United States as evidenced by her present
status as the leading money winner woman's professional golfer
and

WHEREAS, she has previously demonstrated her skills and
character by becoming the second youngest person ever to win
the National Women's Amateur Golf Title in 1957 and in winning
as an amateur and as a professional, other titles and tournaments
too numerous to herein itemize and set forth, and

WHEREAS, her golfing experience began while a student and
resident in her home town, and

WHEREAS, she will be visiting her parents and her home
town on Tuesday, September 17, 1974, and

WHEREAS, the Kirkland City Council desires to recognize
and commend JoAnne Gunderson Carner for her contributions to
womens' athletics and to her home town,


NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Kirkland
does hereby declare Tuesday, September 17, 1974 to be JoAnne
Gunderson Carner Day and the Kirkland City Council does further
call upon all residents and citizens of the City of Kirkland to
join in the celebration and observance of JoAnne Gunderson Carner
Day, and in so doing to express to her personally their congratu-
lations and appreciation.
