

RESOLUTION NO. R-2272

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND WITHDRAWING PERMISSION TO MAKE SEWER SERVICE CONNECTIONS AND EXTENSIONS TO THE EXISTING CITY OF KIRKLAND SEWER SYSTEM LYING WITHIN CERTAIN AREAS OUTSIDE OF THE KIRKLAND CITY LIMITS.

WHEREAS, pursuant to RCW 35.67.310 service connections and/or extensions to the City of Kirkland sewer system lying outside of the city limits requires the prior permission of the city, and


WHEREAS, the city has heretofore either specifically or by acquiescence indicated that such permission existed, and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that studies relating to actual costs of service, maintenance and system extensions are necessary and advisable before any further such service connections or extensions are made within certain areas lying outside of the city,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Kirkland, as follows:


Section 1. The permission heretofore given, either specially or by acquiescence to make service connections or extensions to the existing Kirkland sewer system outside the corporate limits of the City of Kirkland, is hereby withdrawn and no further service connections or extensions shall be made to the existing City of Kirkland sewer system within said area until such time as the City Council may hereafter authorize.

PASSED by a majority vote of the Kirkland City Council in regular meeting on the 21st day of October, 1974.
