A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND AND NOTICE OF HEARING FOR THE STREET VACATION OF A PORTION OF SIXTH AVENUE SOUTH, FILE NO. V-74-42.
