

RESOLUTION NO. R-2308

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO SIGN ON BEHALF OF THE CITY A CONTRACT WITH THE FIRM OF KRAMER, CHIN AND MAYO, INC. AS CONSULTANTS IN THE STUDY OF THE TOTEM LAKE - PAR MAC - UPPER JUANITA BAY VALLEY AREA OF THE CITY.

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. R 2301 adopted April 21, 1975, the City Council did declare that development of land policies, goals and regulations for the area within Kirkland generally referred to as the Totem Lake - Par Mac - upper Juanita Bay Valley area involve identification and study of many interrelated factors, including economic, marketing, industrial, social, environmental, urban design and circulation, and

WHEREAS, the City Council deems it to be in the best interests of the City and its residents, including the property owners and business owners within said area to hire skilled consultants to perform a study of said area for use in the preparation of the City's comprehensive land use and development policy plan and any present and future development within said area, and

WHEREAS, the firm of Kramer, Chin and Mayo, Inc. has demonstrated to the satisfaction of the Citizens Advisory Committee and the City staff that they have such skill and are willing to provide such service,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:

Section 1. The Mayor of the City of Kirkland is hereby authorized and directed to sign on behalf of the City of Kirkland that certain agreement between the City of Kirkland and Kramer, Chin and Mayo, Inc. attached to the original of this resolution and by this reference incorporated herein.

ADOPTED by a majority vote of the Kirkland City Council in regular meeting on the 19th day of May, 1975.
