

RESOLUTION NO. R 2309

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND APPROVING AN EXTENSION OF THE PROGRAM FOR CITIZEN AWARENESS/ INVOLVEMENT IN CRIME PREVENTION AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY TO APPLY FOR AN EXTENSION OF ITS EXISTING PROGRAM GRANT TO FUND SAID PROJECT.

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. R2264 adopted August 19, 1974, the City Council did approve a Kirkland Police Department program for Citizen Awareness/Involvement in Crime Prevention as a part of a regional program to be submitted for law enforcement assistance administration funding, and

WHEREAS, thereafter such funding was granted and such program was commenced, and

WHEREAS, the City Council deems the continuation and extension of said program to be in the public interest,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:


Section 1. The City Manager acting in conjunction with the Kirkland Chief of Police and the Kirkland Police Department is hereby authorized and directed to pursue all steps necessary to carry out an extension of the Citizens Awareness/Involvement in Crime Prevention Project program, including the application and processing of an extension of the LEAA Financial Support and Funding Grant (being identified as LJPO Grant No. 75-C-0011) for the funding period covering the year 1976 and appropriate portion of the year 1977.

ADOPTED by a majority vote of the Kirkland City Council in regular meeting on the 2nd day of June, 1975.
