

RESOLUTION NO. R-2323

A RESOLUTION OF THE KIRKLAND CITY COUNCIL AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR HIS DELEGATE TO MAKE APPLICATION THROUGH THE OFFICE OF COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT, STATE OF WASHINGTON, FOR FEDERAL AND STATE WASTE WATER TREATMENT WORKS CONSTRUCTION FUND GRANTS FOR A STEP 1 FACILITY PLAN FOR A SANITARY SEWER INTERCEPTOR SYSTEM WITHIN THE PAR-MARC INDUSTRIAL AND ADJACENT RESIDENTIAL AREAS.


WHEREAS, the Par-Mac Industrial and adjacent residential areas either lack or are inadequately sewered, and

WHEREAS, federal and state funds are available for the development of a Step 1 facility plan for a sanitary sewer interceptor system within said area,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Kirkland, as follows:


Section 1: The Kirkland City Manager, or the Director of Public Services as his delegate, is hereby authorized and directed to sign on behalf of the City of Kirkland any and all necessary or required applications, documents, and contracts relating to the grant of federal and state grant funds to be used for the development of a Step 1 facility plan for a sanitary sewer interceptor system of gravity and pressure lines to serve the Par-Mac Industrial and adjacent residential areas with discharge to the existing Metro Seattle trunks. The City Council further ratifies any action or application heretofore made by the City Manager or his delegate in regard to such funding grants.
