

RESOLUTION NO. R-2327

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND AND NOTICE OF HEARING FOR THE ALLEY VACATION BETWEEN 106th AVENUE N.E. AND 108th AVENUE N.E. AND BETWEEN N.E. 58th STREET AND N.E. 60th STREET, (FILE NO. V-75-47).

WHEREAS, a petition has been filed with the City of Kirkland signed by owners of interest in real property representing more than two-thirds of the property abutting upon the hereinafter described alley, and

WHEREAS, it appears that the public interest of the City of Kirkland, Washington would be served by the vacation of said alley.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Kirkland:

(1) That a public hearing be held to consider whether the public interest and general welfare of the City of Kirkland will be served by the vacation of that alley situate in Kirkland, King County, Washington, and described as follows:

Eight foot alley to the west of Lots 7 through 12,
Block 4, Burke & Farrars Kirkland Addition, Division 7.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED AND NOTICE OF HEARING:

(2) That said public hearing will be held before the Kirkland City Council in its chambers in the Kirkland City Hall on December 1, 1975, at 8:00 P.M.
