A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND AND NOTICE OF HEARING FOR THE VACATION OF A PORTION OF 112TH AVENUE N.E AND N.E. 58TH STREET, FILE NO. V-75-48. (GAIRLOCH)

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Kirkland:



BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED AND NOTICE OF HEARING:


2) That said public hearing will be held before the Kirkland City Council in its chambers in the Kirkland Council Building on February 17, 1976, at 8:00 P.M.
