

RESOLUTION NO. R-2347

A RESOLUTION OF THE KIRKLAND CITY COUNCIL CREATING A SENIOR CITIZENS CENTER ADVISORY COMMITTEE TO ASSIST THE CITY COUNCIL AND THE CITY ADMINISTRATION IN ALL PHASES OF PLANNING, ACQUISITION AND DEVELOPMENT OF A SENIOR CITIZENS CENTER.

WHEREAS, the City Council has found remodeling of the Armory Building to be presently inadvisable, and

WHEREAS, the City of Kirkland has an on going and active comprehensive program for senior citizens, and

WHEREAS, need for the continuation of such a program is found by the City Council to exist, and

WHEREAS, grant funds are available from various sources for the acquisition and establishment of a Senior Citizens Center, and

WHEREAS, the citizens and residents of Kirkland have expressed their strong desire to establish such a center, and

WHEREAS, public participation and support in the initial phases of planning and grant application are essential as well as desirable, and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that a Citizens Advisory Committee will be of immediate and on going assistance to the City Council and the City Administration in all phases of planning, acquisition and development of a Senior Citizens Center,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Kirkland, as follows:

Section 1. There is hereby created a Senior Citizens Center Advisory Committee to be composed of qualified and interested members drawn from all segments of the general public, including senior citizens. Said Citizens Advisory Committee shall perform the consultation, liaison and advisory functions assigned to it by the City Council and may make such comments and recommendations and provide such other and further assistance to the City Council and the City Administration, as may be appropriate.

The Mayor has recommended and the City Council hereby confirms appointment of the following to the initial members of said Citizens Advisory Committee:

Section 2. The City Manager, or such other City of Kirkland official as the City Manager may designate shall act as the City contact person in regard to all activities of said Citizens Advisory Committee.
