A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND ACCEPTING A STEP 1 GRANT FROM THE ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY TO PREPARE A FACILITIES PLAN FOR THE PAR-MAC INTERCEPTOR - PROJECT IDENTIFICATION NO. C-530750-01-0 - AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SIGN ON BEHALF OF THE CITY THE GRANT AGREEMENT.

WHEREAS, upon application heretofore made by the City and certified for priority by the Washington Department of Ecology, the U. S. Environmental Protection Agency has approved a grant to the City of Kirkland under Project Identification No. C-53075-01-0; and

WHEREAS, said grant is in the amount of \$13,875.00, representing seventy-five percent (75%) of the estimated eligible cost of the preparation of a facilities plan for the Par-Mac Interceptor;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:

Section 1: The City Council for the City of Kirkland does hereby accept the grant offered by the U. S. Environmental Protection Agency under its grant - Project Identification No. C-530750-01-0.

Section 2: The City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to sign on behalf of the City of Kirkland the EPA Grant Agreement.
