RESOLUTION NO. R-2372

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND AND NOTICE OF HEARING FOR A STREET VACATION LOCATED AT THE END OF FIFTH AVENUE, NORTH OF FIFTH STREET, AT THE INTERSECTION OF FIFTH STREET AND SIXTH AVENUE (FILE NO. V-76-52).

WHEREAS, a petition has been filed with the City of Kirkland signed by owner of interest in real property representing more than two-thirds of the property abutting upon the hereinafter described street, and
