

RESOLUTION NO. R-2383

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND AND NOTICE OF HEARING FOR THE ALLEY VACATION LOCATED BETWEEN 10th AVENUE AND 11th AVENUE, WEST OF 8th STREET (FILE NO. V-76-54)

WHEREAS, a petition has been filed with the City of Kirkland signed by owners of interest in real property representing more than two-thirds of the property abutting upon the hereinafter described alley, and

WHEREAS it appears that the public interest of the City of Kirkland, Washington, would be served by the vacation of said alley,

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Kirkland:

1) That a public hearing be held to consider whether the public interest and general welfare of the City of Kirkland will be served by the vacation of that alley situate in Kirkland, King County, Washington, and described as follows:


Addition of $\frac{1}{2}$ width of 16 ft. alley to the west end of Lot Nos 1 through 8, to the east side of lots 9 and 57, to the south end of Lots 9 and 10, and to the north end of lots 56 and 57 in Block 239 of Supplemental Plat to Kirkland in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Sec 5, Twp 25, Rg 5, according to plat thereof recorded in Vol 8 of Plats page 5, Records of King County.

Net area of abandoned alley is 5,056 sq. ft.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED AND NOTICE OF HEARING:


2) That said public hearing will be held before the Kirkland City Council in its chambers in the Kirkland Council Building on October 4, 1976, at 8:00 P.M.
