

## RESOLUTION NO. R-2396

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND, WASHINGTON, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR HIS DELEGATES TO SIGN ON BEHALF OF THE CITY ANY AND ALL REQUIRED DOCUMENTS INCLUDING THE ORIGINAL APPLICATION RELATING TO APPLICATION FOR FEDERAL GRANT UNDER THE LOCAL PUBLIC WORKS CAPITAL AND INVESTMENT PROGRAM OF THE ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT ADMINISTRATION OF THE U. S. DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE FOR CONSTRUCTION OF FIRE STATION NO. 22.

WHEREAS, the City of Kirkland is a noncharter code city under the laws of the State of Washington, and as such, is authorized and does provide fire protection and other emergency services through its Department of Fire Services, and

WHEREAS, the Kirkland Department of Fire Services is in need of a new fire station to be constructed in accordance with the Fire Station Location Plan heretofore adopted by the City and identified as Fire Station No. 22, and

WHEREAS, there are federal grant funds available to assist in said construction through the local Public Works Capital and Investment Program of the Economic Development Agency of the U. S. Department of Commerce; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:

Section 1. The City Council hereby authorizes and directs the City Manager or the Director of Community Development or the Director of Fire Services for the City of Kirkland as his delegates to make application to the Economic Development Administration of the U. S. Department of Commerce for a local Public Works Capital and Investment Program Grant in the amount of \$592,600.00 for construction by the City of Kirkland of Fire Station No. 22 at the location designated therefor in the Fire Station Location Plan heretofore adopted by the City.

Section 2. The City Manager or the Director of Community Development or the Director of Fire Services as his delegates is hereby authorized and directed to sign on behalf of the City of Kirkland any and all necessary or required documents including the initial grant application, contractual agreements and reports relating to the grant application for construction of Fire Station No. 22 as authorized in Section 1 herein above.
