

RESOLUTION NO. R-2457

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND AND NOTICE OR HEARING FOR THE STREET VACATION OF THAT PORTION OF 8TH AVENUE LYING BETWEEN 8TH STREET AND THE BURLINGTON-NORTHERN RAILROAD RIGHT-OF-WAY (FILE NO. V-77-61).

WHEREAS, a petition has been filed with the City of Kirkland signed by owners of interest in real property representing more than two-thirds of the property abutting upon the hereinafter described street, and

WHEREAS, it appears that the public interest of the City of Kirkland, Washington, would be served by the vacation of said street,

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Kirkland:

1) That a public hearing be held to consider whether the public interest and general welfare of the City of Kirkland will be served by the vacation of the street situate in Kirkland, King County, Washington, and described as follows:

That portion of 60 foot right-of-way lying between Block 227 and Block 232 of Supplemental Plat to Kirkland in the NE 1/4 and NW 1/4 of SE 1/4 Sec. 5-25-5.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED AND NOTICE OF HEARING:
