## RESOLUTION R-2467

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND AND NOTICE OF HEARING FOR VACATION OF EIGHTH STREET BETWEEN ELEVENTH AVENUE AND TWELFTH AVENUE (FILE NO. V-77-62).

WHEREAS, a petition has been filed with the City of Kirkland signed by owners of interest in real property representing more than two-thirds of the property abutting upon the hereinafter described street, and

WHEREAS, it appears that the public interest of the City of Kirkland, Washington, would be served by the vacation of said street.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Kirkland:

1) That a public hearing be held to consider whether the public interest and general welfare of the City of Kirkland will be served by the vacation of that street situate in Kirkland, King County, Washington, and described as follows:

"That portion of 8th Street 80 foot right-of-way northerly of north right-of-way line of 11th Avenue in Supplemental Plat to Kirkland and that portion of 8th Street continuing into Lake Addition to Kirkland terminating on southerly right-of-way line of 12th Avenue, all being within NE & Section 5, Township 25, Range 5 W.M."

2) That said public hearing will be held before the Kirkland City Council in its chambers in the Kirkland Council Building on December 5, 1977, at 8:00 P.M.
