

RESOLUTION R-2490

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND AND NOTICE OF HEARING FOR VACATION OF 6TH AVENUE BETWEEN 4TH STREET AND 5TH STREET. (FILE NO. V-78-67).

WHEREAS, a petition has been filed with the City of Kirkland signed by owners of interest in real property representing more than two-thirds of the property abutting upon the hereafter described street, and

WHEREAS, it appears that the public interest of the City of Kirkland, Washington, would be served by the vacation of said street,

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Kirkland;


9) That a public hearing be held to consider whether the public interest and general welfare of the City of Kirkland will be served by the vacation of that street situate in Kirkland, King County, Washington, and described as follows:

That portion of 6th Avenue with common frontage on Block 188 of Kirkland Addition as recorded in Vol 6 of Plats pages 53-57 records of King County, Washington, and Block 89 of Kirkland Terrace as recorded in records, King County, Washington. The area to be vacated is 500 feet in length by 60 feet width for a total of 30,000 square feet.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED AND NOTICE OF HEARING:
