RESOLUTION NO. R-2500

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND ADDRESSED TO THE KING COUNTY COUNCIL ENDORSING THE JOINT SPHERES OF INFLUENCE CONCEPT.

WHEREAS, land use and related development decisions of King County have a significant impact upon the City of Kirkland and provision of municipal services and facilities in and adjacent to the City of Kirkland, and

WHEREAS, some land use and related development decisions of the City of Kirkland may influence development in King County and affect the area-wide planning objectives of King County, and

WHEREAS, elements of adopted plans, policies or development standards of King County and the City of Kirkland are not in total accord, and

WHEREAS, there is now no formal means to resolve conflicts in plans, policies, development standards, or development actions based on such plans, policies and standards, and

WHEREAS, there is a need for a formal procedure for King County and the City of Kirkland to jointly consider those plans, policies, and development actions, and

WHEREAS, an interim means of obtaining the same objectives should be implemented while developing more permanent means, and

WHEREAS, King County has declared by Motion 3090 dated June 27, 1977, its intention of implementing a joint spheres of influence program.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Kirkland does resolve as follows:

Section 1. The joint spheres of influence concept is hereby endorsed as a means to review and resolve land use and related conflicts between King County and the City of Kirkland.

<u>Section 2</u>. The King County Council is urged to undertake actions leading to further consideration of the joint spheres of influence concept between King County and the City of Kirkland.

Section 3. The City Clerk is directed to forward a certified copy of this resolution to the King County Council, King County, Washington.
