

RESOLUTION NO. 2524

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND AND NOTICE OF HEARING FOR THE VACATION OF A PORTION OF 4TH AVENUE BETWEEN 1ST STREET AND 2ND STREET AND THE REMAINING ALLEY IN BLOCK 205, BETWEEN 4TH AND 5TH AVENUE AND 1ST AND 2ND STREET.

WHEREAS, a petition has been filed with the City of Kirkland signed by owners of interest in real property representing more than two-thirds of the property abutting upon the hereinafter described street and alley, and

WHEREAS, it appears that the public interest of the City of Kirkland, Washington, would be served by the vacation of said street and alley,

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Kirkland:

1) That a public hearing be held to consider whether the public interest and general welfare of the City of Kirkland will be served by the vacation of that portion of street and alley situate in Kirkland, King County, Washington, and described as follows:


That portion of 4th Avenue in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 5, TWP 25 N, Range 5E fronting the entire length of Block 210 of Kirkland Addition, and

That portion of Alley contained in Block 205 of Kirkland Addition in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 5, TWP 25N, Range 5E

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED AND NOTICE OF HEARING:


2) That said public hearing will be held before the Kirkland City Council in its chambers in the Kirkland Council Building on July 17, 1978, at 8:00 P.M.
