

RESOLUTION NO. R-2603

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND AND NOTICE OF HEARING FOR THE STREET VACATION LOCATED AT N.E. 66th STREET EAST OF 108th AVENUE N.E. (FILE NO. V-79-79).

WHEREAS, a petition has been filed with the City of Kirkland signed by owner of interest in real property representing more than two-thirds of the property abutting upon the hereinafter described street, and

WHEREAS, it appears that the public interest of the City of Kirkland, Washington would be served by the vacation of said street,

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Kirkland:



BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED AND NOTICE OF HEARING:


2) That said public hearing will be held before the Kirkland City Council in its chambers in the Kirkland Council Building on May 7, 1979, at 8:00 P.M.
