

RESOLUTION NO. 2614

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND AND NOTICE OF HEARING FOR THE VACATION OF A PORTION OF ALLEY WITHIN BLOCK 170 OF KIRKLAND ADDITION BETWEEN 8TH AND 9TH AVENUE. (File No. V-79-80).

WHEREAS, a petition has been filed with the City of Kirkland signed by owners of interest in real property representing more than two-thirds of the property abutting upon the herein-after described alley, and

WHEREAS, it appears that the public interest of the City of Kirkland, Washington, would be served by the vacation of said alley,

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Kirkland:


1) That a public hearing be held to consider whether the public interest and general welfare of the City of Kirkland will be served by the vacation of that portion of alley situate in Kirkland, King County, Washington, and described as follows:

That portion of the alley located in Section 5, township 25 N, Range 5 E, W.M., and within Block 170 of Kirkland addition as recorded in volume 6, pages 61 to 64, of plats in King County, Washington and lying easterly of the West property line of Lot 48 thereof, produced north and adjacent to lots 1 through 19 and 48 through 57 thereof.

2) That said public hearing will be held before the Kirkland City Council in its chambers in the Kirkland Council Building on June 4, 1979, at 8:00 P.M.
