A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND APPROVING AND ADOPTING THE ANNUAL UPDATE FOR THE SIX YEAR STREET AND URBAN ARTERIAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAMS IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 19.08.051, KIRKLAND MUNICIPAL CODE.

WHEREAS, The City is required annually to review and modify or amend as deemed appropriate the six year street and urban arterial programs, and

WHEREAS, the Director of Project and Construction Management has submitted his report and recommendation for review by the City Council as required by State law, and

WHEREAS, public hearing has been held before the City Council on July 16, 1979, and

WHEREAS, the City Council has considered the recommendation and comments received during the public hearing,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:

Section 1. The perpetual six-year transportation and street construction and improvement program, including the urban arterial improvement program for the City of Kirkland, is hereby adopted, modified and amended, all as set forth in Exhibits A, B, C and D to this Resolution, which exhibits are incorporated herein by this reference. Pursuant to Section 19.08.051 of the Kirkland Muncipal Code, said Exhibits A, B and C constitute the Urban Arterial Improvement Program in the form required by RCW Chapter 47.26, and are in conformance to and in furtherance of the circulation element of the Comprehensive Land Use Policies Plan adopted by Kirkland Ordinance No. 2346.

Section 2. A copy of this Resolution, including Exhibit A - Major Arterial Streets; Exhibit B - Secondary Arterial Streets; Exhibit C - Collector Streets: Both Arterial and Neighborhood; and Exhibit D - Residential Street, shall be filed with the Director of the Department of Transportation for the State of Washington as required by law.

REVISED SIX YEAR PROGRAM FOR RESIDENTIAL STREETS

Public hearing on the six year residential street improvement program for the City of Kirkland was held before the City Council of the City of Kirkland on the 16th day of July 1979.

All streets not included in Exhibits A, B, or C are classed as residential including some through streets, dead-ends, and cul-de-sacs all serving the residents of the City.

Projects could include asphaltic concrete overlays, drainage improvements, base work, sidewalk and walkways, signing, striping and any other miscellaneous work declared necessary by the City and estimated to be in the amount of \$120,000.00.

One-half cent gas tax monies will be used for payment of such work.

WHEREAS, there remain as unresolved issues in these consolidated cases, questions of whether any of the plaintiffs' parcels of property were so affected by amendments of particular application not specifically related overall to the newly formulated Comprehensive Plan, together with additional unresolved issues raised by the pleadings and the motions for summary judgment submitted by both plaintiffs and the defendants; and

WHEREAS, all of the parties to the consolidated cases wish to settle the differences between the parties with some certainty and in a manner consistent with the Comprehensive Plan as adopted; and

WHEREAS, fair and reasonable resolution of litigation through settlement is, when possible to obtain, within the public interest and a public benefit,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Kirkland, as follows:

Section 1. The City Council hereby ratifies and approves the action of the attorney for the City of Kirkland in signing on behalf of the City of Kirkland the Stipulation for Entry of Order, Judgment and Decree, a copy of which is attached to the original of this resolution, as Exhibit A, and by this reference is incorporated herein, and in presenting the same together with appropriate orders, judgments and decrees carrying out said Exhibit A to the court for entry.

<u>Section 2</u>. Upon entry of the Order, Judgment and Decree, the provisions thereof shall insofar as the City of Kirkland is concerned, be administered as though said Order, Judgment and Decree were an integral part of the Land Use Policies Plan and the Zoning Code Regulations of the City of Kirkland insofar as they apply to the real properties described in the complaints of the respective plaintiffs.
