A RESOLUTION OF THE KIRKLAND CITY COUNCIL AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO SUCH CONTRACTS AND AGREEMENTS WITH THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AS MAY BE NECESSARY AND REQUIRED IN ORDER FOR THE CITY OF KIRKLAND TO RECEIVE 'CERTIFICATION ACCEPTANCE' AS QUALIFIED TO ADVERTISE FOR AND AWARD BIDS AND LET CONTRACTS FOR CITY STREET PROJECTS FUNDED IN PART BY FEDERAL AIDE.

WHEREAS, the federal government through its Department of Transportation, pursuant to Title 23 US Code Highways, has established programs for federal aide to the states the general purpose of which is to increase the capacity and/or safety of arterials in the United States; and

WHEREAS, the Washington State Department of Transportation is responsible for the expenditure of federal aide funds within the State of Washington; and

WHEREAS, the City of Kirkland and the State of Washington have certain responsibilities as conditions both precedent and subsequent to the receipt of federal aide through federal aide programs for such projects on streets and arterials within the City of Kirkland; and

WHEREAS, such federal and state regulations require state authorization, review, and approval of the contract plans, specifications, advertisement for bid, and award of contract as to each individual project unless the local agency has entered into a "certification acceptance qualification agreement"; and

WHEREAS, the obtaining of individual project approvals are of necessity, time consuming, and may result in unforeseen delay,

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Kirkland, as follows:

Section 1. The City Manager of the City of Kirkland is hereby authorized and directed to sign on behalf of the City of Kirkland such contracts and agreements with the State Department of Transportation as may be necessary and required for the City of Kirkland to receive "certification acceptance" including execution of the "Washington State Department of Transportation Certification Acceptance Qualification Agreement" (copy of which is attached hereto, and by this reference incorporated herein).

Section 2. Pursuant to the Washington State Department of Transportation policy procedures, and certification acceptance local agency guidelines, the Kirkland City Manager is the designated "responsible local official".
