RESOLUTION R-2680

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND AND NOTICE OF HEARING FOR THE VACATION OF THAT CERTAIN EASEMENT FOR UTILITIES RESERVED BY THE CITY AT THE TIME THE HEREIN DESCRIBED PUBLIC RIGHT-OF-WAY WAS VACATED BY ORDINANCE NO. 2364.

WHEREAS, by Ordinance No. 2364, the City of Kirkland did here-tofore vacate the street hereinafter described while reserving an easement, together with the right to exercise and grant easements along, over and across said vacated street for public utility services; and

WHEREAS, a petition has now been filed with the fee owner of said vacated street requesting the further vacation of the retained and reserved easement; and

WHEREAS, it appears that the public interest of the City of Kirkland would be served by the vacation of said retained easement;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Kirkland, as follows:

Section 1. A public hearing shall be held to consider whether the public interest and general welfare of the City of Kirkland will be served by vacation of the easement retained and reserved by the City of Kirkland for public utility services along, over, under and across the following described real property, situated in Kirkland, King County, Washington and described as follows:

That portion of 60 foot right-of-way designated as 8th Avenue, between Block 227 and Block 232 of Supplemental Plat to Kirkland, recorded in Volume 8 of Plats Page 5, in King County, Washington.

Section 2. Notice of Public Hearing: Said public hearing shall be held before the Kirkland City Council in the Kirkland City Council Building at the City Hall, 210 Main Street, Kirkland, Washington on the 7th day of January, 1980, at 8:00 P.M.
