

RESOLUTION NO. R-2697

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND ACKNOWLEDGING THE AVAILABILITY OF ADDITIONAL HOUSING AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT "POPULATION" FUNDS AND ALLOCATING SAME BETWEEN AN EXISTING 1978 PROJECT AND AN APPROVED 1980 PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the City of Kirkland has been advised by King County that \$4,892.00 in additional housing/community development block grant "population" funds are available to the City of Kirkland; and

WHEREAS, said additional "population" funds may be allocated to any approved 1980 and/or added to and used for any previously approved and existing H-CD block grant project; and

WHEREAS, after a review of such a program appears to the City Council that such additional "population" funds should be made available to the 1978 Peter Kirk Walkways (CD-775-78) Project and to the 1980 Senior Center Transportation Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:

Section 1. The additional housing and community development block grant population fund allocation available to the City of Kirkland by virtue of its certified population as set forth in the attached letter from King County (Exhibit "A") in the amount of \$4,892.00 is hereby allocated for use by the City of Kirkland in carrying out the following housing and community development projects;

Senior Center Transportation approved for 1980 program	2,000.00

Section 2. The allocation of additional population funds approved by this resolution shall be deemed to be in addition to any funds previously allocated and approved for said projects.

Section 3. A certified or conformed copy of this resolution shall be delivered to the Housing and Community Development Program Office of King County by not later than February 15, 1980.
