

RESOLUTION NO. R- 2700

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SIGN ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND A CONTRACT PROVIDING FOR FUNDING BY KING COUNTY TO ASSIST IN UNDERWRITING THE EXPENSE OF THE JOINT CITY OF KIRKLAND/KING COUNTY RECREATION PROGRAM CARRIED ON BY THE CITY OF KIRKLAND WITHIN THE CITY OF KIRKLAND AND WITHIN THAT PORTION OF UNINCORPORATED KING COUNTY SURROUNDING THE CITY OF KIRKLAND.

WHEREAS, the City of Kirkland, in agreement with King County, has for the past several years, provided a joint recreation program for the City of Kirkland, that portion of unincorporated King County surrounding the City of Kirkland; and


WHEREAS, King County has agreed to increase its contribution towards the cost of said joint recreation program for the calendar year 1980 to an amount not to exceed \$16,000.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:


Section 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to sign on behalf of the City of Kirkland that certain contract for services between the City of Kirkland and King County, wherein King County agrees to contribute an amount not to exceed \$16,000.00 toward the cost of the Kirkland King County Joint Recreation Program, to be conducted within the City of Kirkland and the unincorporated area of King County surrounding the City of Kirkland for the calendar year 1980 (a copy of said contract is attached to the original of this resolution as Exhibit A).

CONTRACT FOR TECHNICAL/PROFESSIONAL SERVICES

THIS AGREEMENT, entered into as of this 1st day of January, 1980,  
by the King County PARKS Department, hereinafter  
referred to as the "County", and CITY OF KIRKLAND  
hereinafter referred to as the "Contractor".

W I T N E S S E T H:

WHEREAS, the County is undertaking certain activities necessary to  
Provide Joint Recreation Program, and,

WHEREAS, the County desires to engage the Contractor to render certain  
technical advice or professional services in connection with such undertakings  
of the County,

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties do mutually agree as follows:

1. Scope of Services. Joint Recreation Program

2. Time of Performance. The services of the Contractor are to commence  
on the 1st day of January, 1980 and terminate on the  
31st day of December, 1980. The duration of the contract  
may be extended or terminated upon mutual agreement between the parties  
hereto and pursuant to the terms and conditions of the agreement.

3. Compensation and Method of Payment.  
a. The County shall reimburse the Contractor for the services as  
specified in Section 1 in the following manner: Not to exceed  
\$16,000. Payment Schedule: \$6,000.00 March, 1980; \$6,000.00  
August, 1980; and \$4,000.00 November, 1980.

- b. In the event the work can be accomplished in less than the estimated hours, the Contractor shall bill the County for actual hours worked only.
- c. The Contractor shall submit a properly executed invoice and expenditure report upon completion of said scope of services, together with a final report and recommendation.
- 4. Changes. Either party may request changes in scope of services, performing or reporting standards to be performed or provided hereunder. Proposed changes which are mutually agreed upon shall be incorporated by written amendments to this agreement, signed by both parties.
- 5. Non-Discrimination. The Contractor certifies that it is an equal opportunity employer and agrees to the conditions of King County Ordinance No. 4528. The Contractor entering into contract or agreement with King County valued at One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) or more shall submit to the County Executive a total personnel inventory employment profile providing minority, female, and handicap employment data.
- 6. The Contractor agrees to the conditions of King County Ordinance No. 2361. Studies costing in excess of Two Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$2,500.00) shall require a Consultant Disclosure Form (Exhibit 1).
