RESOLUTION NO. R- 2702

A RESOLUTION OF THE KIRKLAND CITY COUNCIL AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A "MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING" BETWEEN THE CITY OF KIRKLAND AND THE KING COUNTY RETIRED SENIOR VOLUNTEER PROGRAM.
