A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND GRANT-ING A SIX-MONTH EXTENSION TO THE APPLICANT IN DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT FILE NO. R-79-64(P), AS ADOPTED IN CITY OF KIRKLAND RESOLUTION NO. R-2661 FOR DAN BAGGENSTOS.

WHEREAS, Section 23.62.120 of Ordinance No. 2183 requires that the applicant for Intent to Rezone make application for a Building Permit six months from the date of the adoption of the Resolution granting the Conditional Use Permit, unless the City Council grants a six-month extension upon the recommendation of the Kirkland Planning Commission, and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. R-2661 was adopted by the Kirkland City Council in regular meeting on October 1, 1979, and

WHEREAS, Marlin D. Bailey, the legal owner of the subject property, has submitted to the Kirkland Planning Commission a written request for an extension of the time limitation for a period of six months to September 30, 1980, and

WHEREAS, the Kirkland Planning Commission at their meeting of February 21, 1980, considered said application for time extension and have recommended the approval of same to the Kirkland City Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:

Section 1. The application for Building Permit shall be received by September 30, 1980. No further extensions shall be authorized.

Section 2. A certified copy of this Resolution shall be delivered to the applicant of record in the Department Community Development File No. R-79-64(P), and a conformed copy shall be delivered to the following:

- (a) Department of Community Development of the City of Kirkland
- (b) Building and Fire Department of the City of Kirkland
