

RESOLUTION NO. R- 2760

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND ADHERING TO ITS EARLIER DECISION TO LOCATE THE NEW CITY HALL FACILITY AT THE FORMER CENTRAL ELEMENTARY SCHOOL SITE AND DIRECTING THE ARCHITECT AND THE SPECIAL CITY HALL ADVISORY COMMITTEE TO CONTINUE PLANNING FOR THE PREPARATION OF PRELIMINARY PLANS IN ACCORDANCE HEREWITH.

WHEREAS, the Kirkland City Council remains committed to utilization of the former Central Elementary School property for a new City Hall facility; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has heretofore determined not to attempt renovation of the existing Central Elementary School building, now, therefore,


BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:

Section 1. The City Council directs the architect and the Special City Hall Advisory Committee to proceed with further consideration and review of possible internal space requirements and allocations and recommendations for preliminary floor plans within the generalized concept previously identified by the architect as Alternative E. Reports and recommendations are to be made to the City Council prior to the finalization of preliminary floor plans.

Section 2. The City Council further requests the Special City Hall Advisory Committee, in association with the architect, to provide to the City Council and to the City Administration an inventory of materials recommended to be saved or salvaged from the existing Central School Building; examples of such materials might include slate blackboards, bricks, and any other items having a potential, practical, historical, or unique future utilization.
