

RESOLUTION NO. R- 2771

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND APPROVING THE JULY 1981 THROUGH JUNE 1982 ONE YEAR HOUSING AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM ESTABLISHING PRIORITIES AS TO AMOUNT OF FUNDS TO BE ALLOCATED EACH INDIVIDUAL PROGRAM AND THE SOURCE OF SAID FUNDS AND DECLARING SAID ONE YEAR PROGRAM TO BE CONSISTENT WITH AND TO ADDRESS THE PROBLEMS IDENTIFIED IN THE THREE YEAR HOUSING AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT PLAN HERETOFORE APPROVED ON SEPTEMBER 15, 1980, BY RESOLUTION NO. R-2756.

WHEREAS, the City of Kirkland jointly participates with King County in the application for funds pursuant to the Federal Housing and Community Development Act of 1974; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to said act, the City is required to develop and approve a program plan for the year commencing July 1981 and ending June 1982, which plan shall be consistent with and address the needs identified in the three year plan heretofore approved by the City Council on September 15, 1980 by Resolution No. R-2756; and

WHEREAS, the City Administration has developed and recommended such a one year program plan to the City Council; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has received said one year program plan, held a public hearing thereon on November 3, 1980, and approved said plan, now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:

Section 1. The City Council hereby approves, after consideration and review, the one year program plan for the period of July 1, 1981 through June 30, 1982, and finds and declares said plan to be consistent with and to address the problems identified in the three year housing and community development plan adopted for the City of Kirkland by Resolution No. R-2756, pursuant to the requirements of the Federal Housing and Community Development Act of 1974. A copy of said plan, as hereby approved, is attached to the original of this resolution and incorporated herein.

Section 2. The one year program plan herein approved and adopted consists of the following individual programs for which priority amount of funding and identification of funding source, i.e., population funds or Needs funds are as set forth below:
