

RESOLUTION NO. R - 2793

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND AND NOTICE OF HEARING FOR THE VACATION OF A PORTION OF 4TH AVENUE AND CORNER PORTION OF 5TH AVENUE FROM 4TH STREET TO 5TH STREET FOR A TOTAL AREA OF 34,152 SQUARE FEET, (FILE NO. VC-81-3).

WHEREAS, a petition has been filed with the City of Kirkland signed by an owner of interest in real property representing more than two-thirds of the property abutting upon the hereinafter described portions of 4th Avenue and 5th Avenue.

WHEREAS, it appears that the public interest of the City of Kirkland, Washington, would be served by holding a public hearing to consider the vacation of said portions of 4th Avenue and 5th Avenue.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Kirkland:

1) That a public hearing be held to consider whether the public interest and general welfare of the City of Kirkland will be served by the vacation of those portions of 4th Avenue and 5th Avenue, situate in Kirkland, King County, Washington, and described as follows:

That portion of 5th Avenue (Clarkson Avenue) and 4th Avenue (Bessemer Avenue), lying southwesterly of a line connecting the southeast corner of Block 89 and the northeast corner of Block 96 and northeasterly of the southerly extension of the west line of said Block 89 and the northerly extension of the westerly line of said Block 96, all in the Plat of Kirkland Terrace as recorded in Volume 21 of Plats, Page 42, Records of King county, Washington.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED AND NOTICE OF HEARING:


2) That said public hearing will be held before the Kirkland City Council in its chambers in the Kirkland Council Building on February 17, 1981, at 8:00 p.m.
