

RESOLUTION NO. R-2845

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND AND NOTICE OF HEARING FOR THE VACATION OF THE WESTERN 20 FEET OF 8TH STREET, LYING BETWEEN THE NORTH MARGIN OF 7TH AVENUE AND THE SOUTH MARGIN OF 8TH AVENUE, (FILE NO. VC-81-76.).

WHEREAS, a petition has been filed with the City of Kirkland signed by an owner of interest in real property representing more than two-thirds of the property abutting upon the hereinafter described portions of 8th Street.

WHEREAS, it appears that the public interest of the City of Kirkland, Washington, would be served by holding a public hearing to consider the vacation of said portion of 8th Street.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Kirkland:


1) That a public hearing be held to consider whether the public interest and general welfare of the City of Kirkland will be served by the vacation of a portion of 8th Street, situate in Kirkland, King County, Washington, and described as follows:

The westerly 20 feet of 8th Street (111th Ave. N.E.), lying between the north margin of 7th Avenue and the south margin of 8th Avenue, adjoining Parcel A, City of Kirkland Short Plat 78-10-13 Snyder, Recording No. 7811070884, records of King County, Washington.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED AND NOTICE OF HEARING:

2) That said public hearing will be held before the Kirkland City Council in its chambers in the Kirkland Council Building on August 3, 1981, at 8:00 p.m..
