

RESOLUTION NO. R - 2863

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND AND NOTICE OF HEARING FOR THE VACATION OF 73,267 SQUARE FEET OF THE 117th PLACE N.E. RIGHT-OF-WAY BETWEEN N.E. 95TH AND N.E. 100TH STREETS FOR THE PROPOSED EDWARD PLACE SUBDIVISION IN A SINGLE FAMILY ZONE (RS 8500), (FILE NO. VC-81-129).

WHEREAS, a petition has been filed with the City of Kirkland signed by an owner of interest in real property representing more than two-thirds of the property abutting upon the hereinafter described portions of 117th Place N.E..

WHEREAS, it appears that the public interest of the City of Kirkland, Washington, would be served by holding a public hearing to consider the vacation of said portion of 117th Place N.E..

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Kirkland:


1) That a public hearing be held to consider whether the public interest and general welfare of the City of Kirkland will be served by the vacation of a portion of 117th Place N.E. right-of-way, situate in Kirkland, King County, Washington, and described as follows:

That portion of 117th Place N.E. (Arlington Avenue) lying Southerly of the Southerly margin of N.E. 100th Street (Victoria Avenue) and Northeasterly of the Southerly extension of the West line of Block 46 and the Northwesterly extension of the Southerly margin of Block 47, all in the Plat of Burke and Farrar's Kirkland Addition No. 14 as recorded in Volume 20 of Plats, Page 14, Records of King County, Washington.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED AND NOTICE OF HEARING:
