

RESOLUTION NO. R -2885

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND AND NOTICE OF HEARING FOR THE VACATION OF AN ALLEY REQUESTED BY WILMER DENTON, (FILE NO. VC-81-162).

WHEREAS, a petition has been filed with the City of Kirkland signed by an owner of interest in real property representing more than two-thirds of the property abutting upon the hereinafter described alley of Block 123, Burke and Farrar's Kirkland Addition, Division No. 27, located between 1st St. and 2nd St. and 15th and 16th Avenues.

WHEREAS, it appears that the public interest of the City of Kirkland, Washington, would be served by holding a public hearing to consider the vacation of said alley.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Kirkland:

1) That a public hearing be held to consider whether the public interest and general welfare of the City of Kirkland will be served by the vacation of the alley, situate in Kirkland, King County, Washington, and described as follows:

The 16 foot alley of Block 123 of the Plat of "Burke and Farrar's Kirkland Addition to the City of Seattle", Division No. 27 as recorded in Volume 21, Page 90C of Plats, records of King County, Washington.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED AND NOTICE OF HEARING:


2) That said public hearing will be held before the Kirkland City Council in its chambers in the Kirkland Council Building on February 1, 1982, at 8:00 p.m..
