

RESOLUTION NO. R-2889

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICES AS HIS DELEGATE TO SIGN ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND, A CONTRACT WITH THE CITY OF BELLEVUE FOR TRANSFER FROM KIRKLAND TO BELLEVUE, FOUR STEVENS PRINT-PUNCH TRAFFIC RECORDERS.

Whereas, the City of Kirkland owns four Stevens Print-Punch Traffic Recorders used for counting traffic volumes; and

Whereas, the City of Bellevue desires to acquire ownership of same and to compensate the City of Kirkland by providing eighty traffic counts at no cost to the City of Kirkland; and

Whereas, the City Council for the City of Kirkland finds that it is within the public interest and benefit of the City of Kirkland to make such transfer, now, therefore,


Be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:

Section 1. The proposal made by the City of Bellevue to acquire four automatic print-punch traffic recorders owned by the City of Kirkland and the manner of compensation to the City of Kirkland is hereby approved.

Section 2. The City Manager or the Director of Public Services as his delegate, is hereby authorized and directed to sign on behalf of the City that certain agreement, copy of which is attached to the original of this resolution and by this reference incorporated herein, between the City of Kirkland and the City of Bellevue, providing for the transfer of four Stevens Print-Punch Traffic Recorders, Serial Nos. 73494, 73495, 73496 and 73497, having an estimated value of \$800 each.

Passed by majority vote of the Kirkland City Council in regular open meeting on the 4th day of January, 1982.

AGREEMENT

This agreement made and entered into this 9th day of December, 1981, by and between the City of Kirkland acting by and through the Department of Public Works, hereinafter referred to as KIRKLAND; and the City of Bellevue acting by and through the Department of Public Works, hereinafter referred to as BELLEVUE.

WHEREAS, KIRKLAND owns certain property hereinafter described which it desires to make available to BELLEVUE,

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the promises, covenants, conditions and performances set forth below, the parties agree as follows:

1. KIRKLAND agrees to transfer all title and ownership of the following property to BELLEVUE:

4 each:

Stevens Print-Punch Traffic Recorders (Leopold-Stevens Manufacture)

Weight: 19 lbs. (in portable case)

Input voltage: 9 to 14 volts DC or 117 volts - 50/60 Hz
240 volts - 50/60 Hz

Memory Capacity: 0-9999 counts

Size: 19.3" x 11.5" x 11.25" (in portable case)

Manufacturers Serial Numbers 73494, 73495, 73496, 73497

2. BELLEVUE agrees to assume full title, ownership and responsibility for the above described equipment effective as of 10 days after the signing of this agreement.

3. BELLEVUE agrees to compensate KIRKLAND for this transferral of ownership by providing the following services: 80 continuous machine

counts, however, a minimum of 3 counts shall be requested at the same time for each time period. Each count will run for a maximum of 6 days and utilize 1 traffic recorder with either 1 or 2 tubes in operation. The data from each count will be processed and delivered within two weeks from the conclusion of the count. BELLEVUE will not be responsible for accuracy of count data but will strive to provide reasonable count data.

4. These services will be provided upon a written request from KIRKLAND, dated two weeks prior to the requested date of the count.

5. KIRKLAND agrees that upon delivery of the data from the 80th requested count, all claims on the above mentioned equipment are annulled and forfeit. However, all claims are annulled and forfeit by January 1, 1984 regardless of the number of counts provided.




