A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND APPROVING THE ISSUANCE OF A CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT AS APPLIED FOR IN DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT FILE NO. CZ-81-167, BY KIRKLAND CONVALESCENT CENTER TO ERECT A FREE-STANDING SIGN BEING WITHIN A RESIDENTIAL MULTI-FAMILY 3600 ZONE, AND SETTING FORTH CONDITIONS TO WHICH SUCH CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT SHALL BE SUBJECT.

WHEREAS, the Department of Community Development has received an application for a CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT filed by Kirkland Convalescent Center, the owner of said property described in said application and located within a RM 3600 zone.

WHEREAS, the application has been submitted to the Kirkland Planning Commission and Houghton Community Council, respectively, who held hearings thereon at their regular meetings of January 26, 1982 and February 4, 1982, respectively, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to City of Kirkland Ordinance No. 0-2473 concerning environmental policy and the State Environmental Policy Act, this action is exempt per WAC 197-10-170(1)(e).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:

<u>Section 1.</u> The Findings, Conclusions and Recommendations of the Kirkland Planning Commission as signed by the Chairperson thereof and filed in the Department of Community Development File No. CZ-81-167 are adopted by the Kirkland City Council as though fully set forth herein.

Section 2. The CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT shall be issued to the applicant subject to the conditions set forth in the Recommendations hereinabove adopted by the City Council.

<u>Section 3.</u> A certified copy of this Resolution, together with the Findings, Conclusions and Recommendations therein adopted shall be attached to and become a part of the CONDI-TIONAL USE PERMIT or evidence thereof delivered to the permittee.

<u>Section 4.</u> Nothing in this resolution shall be construed as excusing the applicant from compliance with any federal, state or local statutes, ordinances or regulations applicable to this project, other than expressly set forth herein.

Section 5. Failure on the part of the holder of the permit to initially meet or maintain strict compliance with the standards and conditions to which the CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT is subject shall be grounds for revocation in accordance with Ordinance No. 2183, the Kirkland Zoning Ordinance.



Section 6. Notwithstanding any recommendations heretofore given by the Houghton Community Council, the subject matter of this Resolution and the CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT herein granted are, pursuant to Ordinance 2001, subject to the disapproval jurisdiction of the Houghton Community Council, and therefore, this Resolution shall become effective only upon approval of the Houghton Community Council or the failure of said Community Council to disapprove this Resolution within 60 days of the date of the passage of this Resolution.
