

RESOLUTION R-2917

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND RECOGNIZING THAT SEATTLE HAS BEEN SELECTED AS THE HOST CITY FOR THE 1983 NATIONAL CONFERENCE OF THE AMERICAN PLANNING ASSOCIATION AND INVITING THE CONSIDERATION OF KIRKLAND AS THE SITE FOR A MOBILE WORKSHOP.

WHEREAS, the Seattle Area has been selected to host the 1983 Annual Conference of the American Planning Association, and

WHEREAS, one important aspect of these conferences are mobile workshops to tour nearby communities that have been successful in implementing innovative and progressive City planning, and

WHEREAS, the City of Kirkland has a number of land use neighborhoods and specific projects that would provide an interesting and informative case study for such a mobile workshop, and


WHEREAS, the members of the Kirkland Planning Commission, who are members of the American Planning Association, as well as members of the City Council and the staff would benefit from such an exchange of ideas.

THE CITY COUNCIL of the City of Kirkland, Washington, does resolve as follows:

Section 1. The City of Kirkland, Washington, invites the Local Programs and Exhibits Committee of the American Planning Association to consider the City of Kirkland as a site for a mobile workshop associated with the 1983 National Conference in Seattle.
