A RESOLUTION OF THE KIRKLAND CITY COUNCIL AUTHORIZING A TRANSFER OF \$3,520.78 FROM THE HOUSING/COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT CBD STREET CROSSINGS/PEDESTRIAN SAFETY IMPROVEMENTS (CD-A109-80) TO THE 1981 HOUSING/COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM: SIXTH STREET SIDEWALK (CD-1064-81).

Whereas, the City Council of the City of Kirkland has been advised that funds necessary to complete the CBD street crossings/pedestrian safety improvements program are available from sources other than Housing and Community Development block grant funds; and

Whereas, the City council has been further advised that additional housing/community development funds are necessary to complete the 1981 Housing-Community Development Sixth Street sidewalk program; and

Whereas, it appears to the City council based upon the foregoing that \$3,520.78 of Housing and Community Development block grant population funds now allocated to the 1980 CBD street crossings and pedestrian safety improvement program should be transferred and allocated to the 1981 Housing and Community Development Sixth Street sidewalk program, now, therefore.

BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:

Section 1. A transfer of \$3,520.78 of Housing and Community block grant population funds now allocated to the 1980 CBD street crossing/pedestrian safety improvements program (CD-Al09-80) to the 1981 H/CD Sixth Street sidewalk program (CD-1064-81) be and it hereby is authorized.

Section 2. The City Manager and the Director of Administration and Finance are hereby authorized and directed to take such steps as may be necessary and required to effect the transfer authorized by Section 1 of this resolution.

Section 3. A certified or conformed copy of this resolution shall be delivered to the Housing and Community Development Program Office of King County.
