

RESOLUTION NO. R - 2991

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND AND NOTICE OF HEARING FOR
THE VACATION OF A PORTION OF AN ALLEY, (FILE NO. VC-82-98).

WHEREAS, a petition has been filed with the City of Kirkland signed by an owner of interest in real property representing more than two-thirds of the property abutting upon the hereinafter described portions of the alley located south of 3rd Ave., east of 1st St., north of Central Way and west of 2nd St. in CBD-B zone.

WHEREAS, it appears that the public interest of the City of Kirkland, Washington, would be served by holding a public hearing to consider the vacation of said portion of alley.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Kirkland:


1) That a public hearing be held to consider whether the public interest and general welfare of the City of Kirkland will be served by the vacation of said portion of alley, situated in Kirkland, King County, Washington, and described as follows:

The northerly 110 feet of an alley 16 feet in width, lying southerly of 3rd Ave. (Seattle Avenue), easterly of Block 215 and westerly of Block 214, in the Plat of the Town of Kirkland, as recorded in Volume 6 of plats, pages 53-67, records of King County, Washington. Containing 1,760 square feet, more or less.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED AND NOTICE OF HEARING:


2) That said public hearing will be held before the Kirkland City Council in its chambers in the Kirkland Council Building on February 22, 1983, at 8:00 p.m..
