RESOLUTION NO. R-3006

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND PERTAINING TO THE ESTABLISHMENT OF CONGRESSIONAL DISTRICTS.

Whereas, the City of Kirkland has for many years, been bisected by a congressional district boundary; and

Whereas, said congressional district boundary tends to memorialize the old boundary line between the former City of Kirkland and the former City of Houghton now consolidated into the consolidated City of Kirkland; and

Whereas, the City Council of the City of Kirkland believes that the citizens, residents and voters of the consolidated City of Kirkland would be best served by a single congressional representative, now, therefore,

Be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:

Section 1. The City Council of the City of Kirkland hereby respectfully requests the Washington Congressional Redistricting Commission established by the Washington State legislature to, in carrying out its commissioned task, place the entire City of Kirkland within a single congressional district.

Section 2. The Deputy City Clerk for the City of Kirkland is hereby directed to forward to the chairman of the Congressional Districting Commission, a conformed or certified copy of this resolution.
