RESOLUTION NO. R-3013

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND APPROVING THE PRELIMINARY SUBDIVISION AND PRELIMINARY PLAT OF SLOWINSKI'S ADDITION AS APPLIED FOR BY WALT SLOWINSKI BEING DEPARTMENT OF PLANNING AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT FILE NO. III-82-92 AND SETTING FORTH CONDITIONS TO WHICH SUCH PRELIMINARY PLAT SHALL BE SUBJECT.

WHEREAS, the Department of Planning and Community Development has received application for a subdivision and preliminary plat of property within a Residential Single Family 8.5 zone zone and said application having been made by Walt Slowinski the owner of the real property described in said application; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to City of Kirkland Ordinance No. 2473 concerning environmental policy and the State Environmental Policy Act, this action is exempt from the Environmental Checklist process; and

WHEREAS, the proposal for subdivision and preliminary plat has been submitted to the Kirkland Planning Commission who held public hearing thereon at their regular meeting of March 17, 1983; and

WHEREAS, the Kirkland Planning Commission, after public hearing and consideration of the recommendations of the Department of Planning and Community Development, did adopt certain Findings, Conclusions and Recommendations and did recommend approval of the subdivision and the preliminary plat subject to the specific conditions set forth in said recommendation, and

WHEREAS, the City Council, in regular meeting, did consider the environmental documents received from the responsible official, together with the recommendation of the Planning Commission.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:

<u>Section 1</u>. The Findings, Conclusions and Recommendations of the Kirkland Planning Commission as signed by the Chairperson thereof and filed in Department of Planning and Community Development File No. III-82-92 are hereby adopted by the Kirkland City Council as though fully set forth herein.

Section 2. The subdivision and preliminary plat of Slow-inski's Addition is hereby given approval subject to the conditions set forth in the recommendations hereinabove adopted by the City Council.

<u>Section 3</u>. Nothing in this Resolution shall be construed as excusing the applicant from compliance with all federal, state, or local statutes, ordinances, or regulations applicable to this subdivision other than as expressly set forth herein.

Section 4. Notwithstanding any recommendations heretofore given by the Houghton Council herein granted are, pursuant to Ordinance 2001, subject to the disapproval jurisdiction of the Houghton Community Council, and therefore, this Resolution shall become effective only upon approval of the Houghton Community Council or the failure of said Community Council to disapprove this Resolution within 60 days of the date of the passage of this Resolution.

Section 5. A certified copy of this Resolution, along with the Findings, Conclusions and Recommendations hereinabove adopted, shall be attached to and become a part of the evidence of the preliminary approval of said subdivision and preliminary plat to be delivered to the applicant.

Section . Certified or conformed copies of this Resolution shall be delivered to the following:

- (a) Department of Planning and Community Development of the City of Kirkland
- (b) Building and Fire Department of the City of Kirkland
- (c) Project and Construction Management Division of the Public Works Department of the City of Kirkland

- (e) Office of the Director of Administration and Finance (ex officio City Clerk) for the City of Kirkland
