

RESOLUTION NO. R 3048A

A RESOLUTION OF THE KIRKLAND CITY COUNCIL RESPONDING TO THE SECOND DRAFT OF THE KING COUNTY GENERAL DEVELOPMENT GUIDE AND THE RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE EXECUTIVE TASK FORCE ON GROWTH MANAGEMENT.

WHEREAS, King County is undertaking a revision of its comprehensive plan called the General Development Guide; and

WHEREAS, a Second Draft of the General Development Guide was issued in 1981 and thereafter submitted for public review; and

WHEREAS, the County Executive appointed an Executive Task Force on Growth Management to resolve issues raised about the Second Draft of the General Development Guide; and

WHEREAS, the Executive Task Force has issued its recommendations to the County Executive; and

WHEREAS, the County Executive is preparing a Third Draft of the General Development Guide to propose for adoption by the King County Council; and

WHEREAS, the proposed policies of the Second Draft of the General Development Guide and the recommendations of the Executive Task Force on Growth Management raise several issues of significance to Kirkland and other cities in King County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Kirkland, as follows:

Section 1. The Kirkland City Council endorses the goals of the Second Draft of the General Development Guide and recognizes the need to establish a comprehensive group of policies to manage County-wide growth.

Section 2. The Kirkland City Council concludes that several of the proposed policies in the Second Draft of the General Development Guide and several of the recommendations of the Executive Task Force on Growth Management would have significant impacts on the City of Kirkland and other cities in King County, particularly the policies encouraging urban densities in unincorporated areas immediately adjacent to City limits.

Section 3. The City of Kirkland shall endeavor to work with other cities in King County to identify issues of common concern raised by the Second Draft of the General Development Guide and by the recommendations of the Executive Task Force on Growth Management and the City of Kirkland shall help to coordinate and articulate the Cities' response to King County.

Section 4. The City of Kirkland shall endeavor to promote a common agreement between King County and the Cities of King County regarding the relationship of the County's and Cities' responsibilities for growth management.


