

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND APPROVING THE ISSUANCE OF A PROCESS III PERMIT AS APPLIED FOR IN DEPARTMENT OF PLANNING AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT FILE NO. III-83-103, BY LAKE WASHINGTON SCHOOL DISTRICT 414 FOR A PLANNED SITE DEVELOPMENT FOR COLLINS SCHOOL BEING WITHIN A RS 8.5 ZONE, AND SETTING FORTH CONDITIONS TO WHICH SUCH PROCESS III PERMIT SHALL BE SUBJECT.

WHEREAS, the Department of Planning and Community Development has received an application for a Process III Permit filed by Lake Washington School District 414, the owner of said property described in said application and located within a RS 8.5 zone.

WHEREAS, the application has been submitted to the Houghton Community Council and Kirkland Planning Commission who held hearings thereon at their regular meetings of January 24, 1984 and February 2, 1984, respectively, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the State Environmental Policy Act, an environmental checklist was prepared by the Lake Washington School District and a negative declaration issued by the School District, as the lead agency, and

WHEREAS, said environmental checklist and negative declaration have been available and accompanied the application through the entire review process, and

WHEREAS, the Houghton Community Council and the Kirkland Planning Commission after their public hearings and consideration of the recommendations of the Department of Planning and Community Development and having available to them the environmental checklist and negative declaration did adopt certain Findings, Conclusions and Recommendations and did recommend approval of the Process III Permit subject to the specific conditions set forth in said recommendations, and

WHEREAS, the City Council, in regular meeting, did consider the environmental documents received from the responsible official, together with the recommendation of the Planning Commission.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:

Section 1. The Findings, Conclusions and Recommendations of the Kirkland Planning Commission as signed by the Chairperson thereof and filed in the Department of Planning and Community Development File No. III-83-103 are adopted by the Kirkland City Council as though fully set forth herein.

Section 2. The Process III Permit shall be issued to the applicant subject to the conditions set forth in the Recommendations hereinabove adopted by the City Council.

Section 3. Nothing in this resolution shall be construed as excusing the applicant from compliance with any federal, state or local statutes, ordinances or regulations applicable to this project, other than expressly set forth herein.

Section 4. Failure on the part of the holder of the permit to initially meet or maintain strict compliance with the standards and conditions to which the Process III Permit is subject shall be grounds for revocation in accordance with Ordinance No. 2740, as amended, the Kirkland Zoning Ordinance.

Section 5. Notwithstanding any recommendations heretofore given by the Houghton Community Council, the subject matter of this Resolution and the Permit herein granted are, pursuant to Ordinance 2001, subject to the disapproval jurisdiction of the Houghton Community Council, and therefore, this Resolution shall become effective only upon approval of the Houghton Community Council or the failure of said Community Council to disapprove this Resolution within 60 days of the date of the passage of this Resolution.


Section 6. A certified copy of this Resolution, together with the Findings, Conclusions and Recommendations therein adopted shall be attached to and become a part of the Process III Permit or evidence thereof delivered to the permittee.

Section 7. Certified or conformed copies of this Resolution shall be delivered to the following:

- (a) Department of Planning and Community Development of the City of Kirkland
- (b) Fire and Building Departments of the City of Kirkland
- (c) Public Works Department of the City of Kirkland
- (d) The Office of the Director of Administration and Finance (ex officio City Clerk) for the City of Kirkland.


