

RESOLUTION R 3100

A RESOLUTION OF THE KIRKLAND CITY COUNCIL AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER TO ADVISE, IN WRITING, LAKE WASHINGTON SCHOOL DISTRICT 414 OF THE CITY'S INTENTION TO SEEK VOTER APPROVAL OF A BOND ISSUE FOR PURCHASE OF THE "WAVERLY SCHOOL SITE."

Whereas, Lake Washington School District 414 has declared surplus, land within the City of Kirkland known as the "Waverly School Site"; and

Whereas, the "Waverly School Site" which overlooks Lake Washington and downtown Kirkland has a long history of public identification by virtue of its school district use and ownership; and

Whereas, under laws relating to disposal of surplus land, a school district is required to sell such land at its approximate market value; and

Whereas, the City Council of the City of Kirkland believes the citizens of Kirkland should be given an opportunity to express, by approval of a bond issue for acquisition of said site, their interest in continued public ownership of the "Waverly School Site," now, therefore,

Be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:

Section 1. The City Manager of the City of Kirkland is hereby authorized and directed to, in writing, advise Lake Washington School District 414 of the City of Kirkland's intention to seek, at the election to be held September 18, 1984, voter approval of a general obligation bond issue in the amount of \$1,600,000 to provide funds for purchase by the City of Kirkland, of the surplus school district land commonly known as the "Waverly School Site." Such writing may be substantially in the form attached to the original of this resolution as Exhibit A.
