

RESOLUTION R 3108

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR THE DIRECTOR OF THE DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATION AND FINANCE, AS HIS DELEGATE, TO EXECUTE AMENDMENTS TO THE EXISTING GARBAGE COLLECTION CONTRACT.

Whereas, pursuant to Section 16.12.010 of the Kirkland Municipal Code, the Kirkland City Council may authorize the City Manager or the Director of the Department of Administration and Finance, as his delegate, to negotiate regarding the garbage collection contract; and

Whereas, the City Manager has requested authority to execute amendments to the existing garbage collection contract with respect to revision of the formula for calculating the relationship of dump fees and salaries to total operating cost; and


Whereas, it appears to be in the best interest of the City and its residents to authorize amendment of the existing garbage collection contract.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:


Section 1. The City Manager and/or the Director of the Department of Administration and Finance, as his delegate, are hereby authorized to execute amendments to the existing garbage collection contract between the City of Kirkland and Sno-King Garbage Company, Inc., to reflect the following: (1) revision of the formula for calculation of dump fees as a percentage of total cost of the contractor from 40 percent to 45 percent effective January 1, 1985; (2) to allow for adjustment in 1987 of the formula used to compute the percent of total cost comprised by dump fees and salaries, if appropriate, based on a review of dump fees and salaries as they relate to total operating cost.
