

RESOLUTION NO. R- 3113

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND DESIGNATING THE SHUMWAY MANSION AS AN HISTORICAL STRUCTURE FOR THE PURPOSES OF THE KIRKLAND UNIFORM BUILDING CODE.

WHEREAS, the Kirkland City Council has heretofore considered and adopted the recommendation of the Kirkland Planning Commission that property to which the Shumway house is to be relocated be designated, upon completion of such relocation, with an historic overlay zone (City of Kirkland Department of Planning and Community Development File No. III-84-39); and

WHEREAS, Findings of Fact II.D.2a,b and Conclusion III.B.1, adopted by the City Council pursuant to Resolution No. R-3107, amount to the designation of the Shumway Mansion as an historic structure; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:


Section 1. For the purposes of the provisions of the Kirkland Uniform Building Code relating to the repair, maintenance and restoration of historic structures, the Shumway Mansion, as described and identified City of Kirkland Department of Planning and Community Development File No. III-84-39, is hereby designated as an historic structure and such designation shall apply to said structure at both its original location and the location to which it is to be moved as permitted by Kirkland City Council Resolution No. R-3107.
