DETAILED DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED WORK:

The project will involve; street widening, left turn lane installation, roadbed rebuilding, curbs, gutters, sidewalks, underground storm drainage and related drainage improvements, bike lanes, bus turnouts, shoulder improvements, signal improvements, signal interties, channelization intersection approach improvements, revised signing and street lighting. The signals at Kingsgate Way NE/120th Ave. N.E. and Kingsgate Way N.E./N.E. 132nd Street will have additional phases added and channelization revisions. The signal at Kingsgate Way N.E./120th Ave. N.E. will be intertied to the signal at 124th Ave. N.E./N.E. 124th Street as well as the signals at the I-405/N.E. 124th interchange. The attached maps show the location of and the typical cross-sections which will be built on Kingsgate Way N.E.

STATE CONDITION FOR WHICH PROJECT RATED IN PRIORITY ARRAY FOR AUTHORIZATION AND THE MANNER IN WHICH THE DESIGN OF THE PROPOSED CONSTRUCTION WILL ALLEVIATE THE CONDITION.

The project rated in priority array for authorization due to a deficiency evidenced by low operating speed. The proposal will add sufficient pavement width, traffic lanes, and channelization to Kingsgate Way N.E. so that adequate capacity will exist for existing and future traffic volumes using the street and increase the current level of Service E (over capacity) to a B- (adequate flow). The signal at 120th Ave. N.E./Kingsgate Way N.E. will be rebuilt and rephased to expediously utilize the intersection and will be interconnected with the signal at 124th Ave. N.E./N.E. 124th Street as well as the signal at the northbound terminal ramp at I-405/N.E. 124th Street to best make use of the new signal and improvements to 124th Ave. N.E./N.E. 124th Street.

IDENTIFY CHANGES BETWEEN THE SCOPE OF WORK OF THE PROPOSED CONSTRUCTION PROJECT AND THE CONSTRUCTION WORK CONTEMPLATED IN THE PREVIOUS EVEN-NUMBERED YEAR 'S SIX-YEAR CONSTRUCTION PROGRAM AND THE PRELIMINARY PROPOSAL PROSPECTUS AND AN EXPLANATION AND JUSTIFICATION OF SUCH CHANGES.

Roadway Section "A: (that portion between the BNRR and 120th Avenue N.E.) has been modified to provide a continuous 2-way left turn lane and a dedicated left turn lane for northbound traffic at the intersection of 120th N.E.. This revision was made in preparation for the future modification to the I-405 access ramps by the Wash.State Dept. of Transportation. The added lane will accommodate traffic entering the proposed new on-ramp for north bound I-405. (see attached area map).
