

RESOLUTION NO. R-3156

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND AND NOTICE OF HEARING FOR THE VACATION OF A PORTION OF 11TH AVENUE, (FILE NO. VC-85-11).

WHEREAS, a petition has been filed with the City of Kirkland signed by owners of interest in real property representing more than two-thirds of the property abutting upon the hereinafter described portions of 11th Avenue.

WHEREAS, it appears that the public interest of the City of Kirkland, Washington, would be served by holding a public hearing to consider the vacation of said portion of 11th Avenue.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Kirkland:

1) That a public hearing be held to consider whether the public interest and general welfare of the City of Kirkland will be served by the vacation of a portion of 11th Avenue, situate in Kirkland, King County, Washington, and described as follows:


Those portions of 11th Avenue lying east of the eastern margin of 8th Street and west of the western margin of the Northern Pacific Railway Company right-of-way; together with those portions of an unnamed alley lying north of the north margin of 8th Street and lying west of the western margin of the Northern Pacific Railway Company right-of-way and lying east of the eastern side of Block 241, supplemental plat to Kirkland, according to Plat as recorded in Volume 8 of Plats, Page 5, in King County, Washington.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED AND NOTICE OF HEARING:

2) That said public hearing will be held before the Kirkland City Council in its chambers in the Kirkland Council Building on April 15, 1985, at 8.00 p.m.
