

RESOLUTION NO. R- 3210

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND TO SET A PUBLIC HEARING DATE OF OCTOBER 21, 1985 TO CONSIDER THE RENAMING OF KINGSGATE WAY TO "TOTEM LAKE WAY."

WHEREAS, the City of Kirkland has received a request from certain property owners and businesses in the Totem Lake area asking that the public street known as Kingsgate Way be officially renamed to "Totem Lake Way;" and

WHEREAS, the City of Kirkland has previously authorized the reconstruction and upgrading of the public street currently known as Kingsgate Way and said improvements are scheduled for completion in the fall of this year; and

WHEREAS, it would be advisable to consider the renaming of this facility only after adequate opportunity has been afforded for the public to make a comment.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:

Section 1. October 21, 1985 at 8:00 p.m. in the City Council Chambers there shall be a public hearing to consider the advisability of renaming Kingsgate Way to "Totem Lake Way."

Section 2. The Department of Planning and Community Development shall cause to be posted and published a public notice of said hearing date.
